Activities Covered:

Last week, we travelled from the zoo and the jungle to the farm and learnt all about Farm animals. We explored all the different animals that live on a farm and their habitat.

In **Communication and Language**, we read the story "Wake up on Bumble Farm". We sequenced the story in our own words and chose a farm animal to make as a craft.

In **Personal, Social, and Emotional Development**, we discussed how the role of a farmer is important and explored his duties. We learnt about the vehicles and tools that a farmer needs to be able to work on the farm.

In **Physical Development**, we moved our bodies in different ways when we copy farm animal movements in a yoga activity.

In **Literacy**, we learnt the sounds ai & j. We also learnt their actions, songs, and formation before practicing them in our books. We also made different crafts to help us remember these sounds. The High-Frequency words for last week was **and** & **am**.

In **Mathematics**, we continued with revising the polygon shapes through various hands-on activities such as counting how many sides they have and match them to their correct picture.

In **Understanding the World**, we acted out the 'Old McDonald Had a Farm' song and play a guessing game about farm animal sounds.

On Thursday we arrived at school full of excitement for our first school trip. We travelled to the North Sedra farm to learn about the animals and produce of the farm. We got to feed the animals and ride the pony, camel and water boats. It was a great day out!

It was another fun week learning about animals and we are thrilled for next week's activities.

Upcoming Activities:

This week, we will continue with our topic of **Farm Animals**, and we will focus on the farm animals' produce. We will also explore other products that come from the farm.

For **Communication and Language**, we will be reading the story "The Little Red Hen". We will retell the story with actions as we learn the whole process from planting the grains to baking bread with flour. Then, we will bake our own bread in school.

For **Physical Development**, we will discuss where eggs come from. Then we will have a close look inside a fresh chicken egg and learn its different parts.

In **Literacy**, we will learn the sounds **oa** & **ie**. We will learn their actions, songs, and formation before practicing them in our books. The High-Frequency words for this week are **get** & **big**.

For **Mathematics**, we will introduce the 3D shapes, sphere, cube, cone, and triangular prism. We will use fun hands-on activities to learn these Shapes.

For **Expressive Arts and Design**, we will discover the fruits and vegetables that come from the farm and make a delicious fruit salad!

We have another exciting week to look forward to!
