Preschool Palm Tree Newsletter



We explored where honey comes from and made a beehive craft.

We learned how important it is to drink milk and learned how to milk a cow. We loved this activity!

Activities Covered:

Last week, we continued with our topic of **Farm Animals**, and focused on the farm animals' produce. We matched the animals with the products they produced and explored other products that come from the farm.

In **Communication and Language**, we listened to the story 'How Bees Make Honey'. We also followed Curious George on his honey adventure and later made a beehive artwork. We used our fingers to print bees around the beehive.

In **Personal**, **Social**, and **Emotional Development**, we learnt how it is important to drink milk and where it comes from. We also milked a cow in class which was very exciting!

In **Literacy**, we revised the jolly phonics sounds **p** and **n**. We recalled words beginning with these sounds and practiced writing them. Furthermore, we continued to visually discriminate these sounds amongst others.

In **Mathematics**, we learnt the number 12 and all its attributes. We also practiced the concept of patterns through various hands-on activities.

In **Understanding the World**, we learnt the life cycle of a chicken and discussed the four stages of the life cycle. We also made a hen with a chick's craft.

In **Expressive Art and Design**, we learned all about sheep and which products are made of wool. The activity was followed with a craft.

On **Thursday**, we were visited by a vet who came to teach us how to take good care of our pets. They also told us how some animals were rescued in Qatar.

Upcoming Activities:

This week, we will continue with our animal topic but will be diving under the sea as it's all about **sea animals**. We will explore the underwater world through various fun activities.

In Communication and Language, we will explore sea life and listen to the story 'Way Down Deep in the Deep Blue Sea'. Later, we will make various sea creatures crafts.

In **Personal**, **Social**, and **Emotional Development**, we will reinforce the importance of sharing through the story '**Rainbow** *Fish*' and will make our very own rainbow fish to help us remember the moral of the story.

For **Mathematics**, we will learn the number 13 and all its attributes. We will also learn the concept of measuring sizes and lengths through various hands-on experiments and activities.

In **Literacy**, we will continue to revise the jolly phonics sounds learnt in term 1. This week our focus will be on the sounds c kand e. More reinforcement will be made on their correct formation and identifying them in the environment.

It's going to be another fun week to explore.
