Activities Covered:

Last week, we began a new topic series on **Seasons**. We explored **Autumn** and **Winter**. We learnt how the leaves change colour and even learn how to dance like a snowflake.

In **Communication and Language**, we listened to the story '**Goodbye Autumn and Hello Winter**' and discussed whether we have experienced one of the two seasons. Furthermore, we developed our language by learning new vocabulary.

In **Personal, Social, and Emotional Development**, we learnt about foggy and windy weather in Autumn and cold and snowy weather in winter. Then we explored what type of clothing we should wear in each season to keep us from getting sick.

In **Physical Development**, we tuned in our listening ears to listen to the seasons' music by the famous composer Rivaldi and move our bodies according to different seasons.

In **Literacy**, we learnt the jolly phonics sound /o/. We continued to distinguish it from other sounds and learn its action, song, and formation. Later, we made an octopus craft to help us remember the sound.

For **Mathematics**, we continued to practice the concept of counting backward from 10 to 0 and missing numbers from 1 to 10.

In **Understanding the World**, we conducted an exciting ice fishing experiment using salt, ice, and yarn. It was interesting to see the reaction of salt on ice.

On Thursday, we participated in the autumn and winter games. We raced to collect as many snowballs as we could, then went ice bowling and even raced to ice fish.

What an exciting week it was, learning about seasons!

Upcoming Activities:

This week, we will continue our topic series on **Seasons** and will focus on **Spring**.

In **Communication and Language**, we will listen to the story '**When Spring Comes**' and will discuss what happens to the trees in the spring season.

In **Personal, Social, and Emotional Development**, we will learn about the different seasonal fruits and what's the best time of the year for them. We will also talk about our favourite fruits and why we like to eat them.

In **Mathematics**, we will learn about prepositions and will take part in different hands-on activities to help us understand this new concept better.

In **Literacy**, we will learn the jolly phonics sound /u/. We will continue to differentiate it from other sounds and learn its action, song, and formation.

In **Understanding the World**, we will learn about spring animals and their babies.
