Activities Covered:

term - we got this! We ended off Term 2 with the STEAM Week, Helpers, focusing on 'Non - Emergency Helpers'. and our new Term starts learning all about Community Helpers and last week, we focused on helpers in the emergency field.

In Communication and Language, we explored who community helpers are and focused on the Civil Defence and Qatar Police and what they do for our community.

In Personal, Social and Emotional Development, we learnt the role of doctors and nurses, and we played a role play game, 'going to the doctor'.

In Literacy, we did a revision on all the sounds that we have learnt so far and played some games to help us remember these sounds.

In Maths, we learnt a new shape called the 'Hexagon'. We also learnt about sequencing events and how to describe a familiar route that we use, for example, walking from our classrooms to the gym to play.

In Understanding the World, we learnt 'What is an Emergency?' by discussing different scenarios of emergencies. We also listened to emergency sounds, like a police siren and ambulance, and had to guess and match the sounds we heard to the correct emergency vehicle. We also learnt the very important emergency number that we call - 999 and made a craft to remember this number.

In Expressive Arts and Design, we are in full swing practicing for our upcoming concert, and we are all very excited!

On Thursday, we came to school dressed as our favourite community helper and participated in various activities throughout the day.
