In **Understanding the World**, we talked about who your best friend is. Best friends help us when we are sad, cheer for us when we try something new, and make school even more fun.

In **Expressive Arts**, we made our friendship stones for our very special friend.

On Thursday, our little explorers came together to create a beautiful heart mural, symbolizing kindness and friendship. We also enjoyed some delightful friendship games that brought out smiles and giggles all around!

Upcoming Activities:

This week, we are exploring the topic 'My Health and Healthy Habits.' We will learn about the importance of eating nutritious foods, staying active, and taking care of our bodies. Through fun discussions and hands-on activities, we will discover simple ways to keep healthy every day!

In **Literacy**, we will recognise and practice the phonics sounds "t" and "i" using our Jolly Phonics Workbook. We are excited to explore new sounds and enjoy hands-on activities that make learning to read fun and engaging!

In our **Communication and Language** class, we're going to listen to a story called "Oliver's Vegetables". We will discuss our favourite vegetables, share our thoughts on healthy eating, and practice expressing ideas and asking questions about trying new foods

In **Personal, Social, and Emotional Development**, we will learn about kindness, understanding, and right from wrong. Recognising and reflecting on good and poor behaviour in kindergarten.

In **Mathematics**, our little learners are continuing their adventure in the world of measuring and patterns! They are having fun comparing different sizes, discovering which objects are heavier or lighter, and testing their skills with capacity. We are excited to see the new patterns and discoveries they create as they build on what they've already learned
