## Activities Covered:

Last week, we were exploring the topic 'Transportation.' We talked about the different ways we travel, such as by car, bus, train, airplane, and bicycle. Children learned how transportation helps people move from one place to another and keeps our world connected.

In **Literacy**, we learned the sounds "u" and "l"! To make it even more fun, we created wonderful crafts linked to words that start with this sound. We learned the high-frequency words **the**, **of**, blending sounds letter groups 1,2,

In **Communication and Language**, we listened to the story '**Pete the Cat's Train Trip**' he takes a train trip to visit his grandma.

In **Mathematics**, we continued the topic of 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5—composition of 5.

In **Personal, Social and Emotional Development**, we talked about how to travel safely, whether it's by car or plane.

In **Personal Development**, we made our own paper planes and then we played a plane race game. This was so much fun!

In **Understanding the World**, we explored different types of transport and how it function.

In Expressive **Art Design**, we made our own boat craft. This was so much fun doing it! We even had our own designs on our boats.

On Thursday, we had a fun day learning about road rules and keeping safe! At first, the children were very lively, but as soon as they realized how important it is to use their listening ears, looking eyes, and walking feet while crossing the road, they felt really proud of themselves.

## Upcoming Activities:

This week, we are exploring the topic of '**Road Safety**'. We'll talk about the different ways we move safely on the road, such as walking, cycling, riding in a car, or taking a bus. Children will learn the rules and habits that keep us safe while traveling, like looking both ways, using crosswalks, wearing helmets, and following traffic signals. Each activity will include fun discussions, creative crafts, and stories that help children understand how to travel safely and responsibly.

In Literacy, we're discovering the sounds "f" and "b". Our little learners will have a blast creating fun crafts inspired by words that start with these sounds! Plus, we're getting to know high-frequency words like "**he**" and "**she**" and practicing our blending skills. Learning is such an adventure!

In **Communication and Language**, we will listen to the story '**When I Cross the Street**'. This story will teach us to look both ways, listen for cars, how to use crosswalks, and be careful so I can stay safe.

In **Mathematics**, we will learn about 4-sided shapes. We will introduce and learn the shapes oval, rhombus, heart, star, and pentagon.

We can't wait to explore the world of road safety with our little learners!




Learning the letter sound 'l', here we did a ladybug and lollipop craft. We loved the activity so much!
