Activities Covered:

Last week, we packed our suitcases and had an adventurous week, full of fun! We learnt about different countries in our International Week topic. Our reception group travelled across the world. We visited 2 different countries France and India.

In **Literacy**, we revised the phonics sounds *c, k, e, h, r, m, d*. We used them to spell simple CVC words and listened to the beginning, middle, and end sounds in different words as we completed dictation activities. We also revised the High-Frequency Words *to, and, the, of, he, she*.

In **Mathematics**, we continued exploring our numbers 0-5 and covered introducing zero and its properties. We also explored finding five and the representation of five and how these two numbers work together numerically.

On **Sunday**, we learnt about different languages, famous landmarks, and the currency of Jordan and Portugal. We even We had a blast decorating the flags of these countries.

On **Monday**, we listened to traditional stories and folk tales. Then we made a craft unique to these countries. We used a variety of materials to make the Royal Crown and Rooster of Barcelos.

On **Tuesday**, we came to school dressed in our class country's colours, the same as the flag colours. We participated in a parade and then we traveled to Spain, Italy, Portugal and Jordan with our passports. We had them stamped and had a lovely day filled with joy and laughter. We also learnt the meaning behind the Portuguese and Jodan flags as we decorated them.

On **Thursday**, we came dressed our own countries attire or the colours of the flag. We brought food to school to share for your international feast. It was very yummy to try different dishes. We also played different games from around the world. Some were familiar and some were new to learn.

This week is the last week of the term, and where did time go? We will end it on a high note by learning all about this beautiful country we call our home, **Qatar**.
