## Activities Covered:

This week, we explored the topic of '**Recycling**' and the process of collecting, reusing and reducing waste to understand the processing of materials that would be thrown as trash to turn them into new materials. The focus of our discussion was to build awareness of keeping our earth and environment clean and to build understanding on the purpose of recycling daily use of materials.

In **Literacy**, we completed **Literacy Assessments** and students were assessed on their recognition of letter sounds, blending simple words and understanding of basic high-frequency words.

In **Communication and Language**, we listened to the story '**The Life of a Bottle**' the story taught students about the three R's (Reuse, Reduce and Recycle) on understanding the importance of recycling and the purpose it serves in our environment.

In **Mathematics**, we explored decomposing and composing 2D shapes such as the rhombus, oval, square and pentagon.

In **Personal, Social and Emotional Development**, we discussed what recycling entails and understood the purpose and processes of recycling.

In **Understanding the World**, will sort recyclable materials into assorted recycle bins. This was so much fun!

In **Expressive Art and Design**, we made our crafts from reusable materials and made a flower from bottlecaps and reused cardboard.

On Thursday, we indulged in fun learning activities that revolved around recycling and awareness of keeping our planet clean. We played interactive and physical games while we laughed and socialized with our friends. Such unforgettable memories!
