Activities Covered:

Upcoming Activities:

In **Literacy**, we will be doing revision of all the sounds we have learnt to date, and we will play a game to help us recall the sounds. We will practice blending of 3 letter words sounding them out, for example the words cat, pot, big, cup, bed. We will also play a name game finding the letters in our name.

In **Mathematics**, we will practice our counting skills and play a game to help us remember prepositional language.

In **Expressive, Art and Design**, we will do some painting and some creative art.

Don't forget to go to bed early this week so that we are alert and fresh everyday so that we can perform like super stars in our concert practices! It is going to a busy week!
